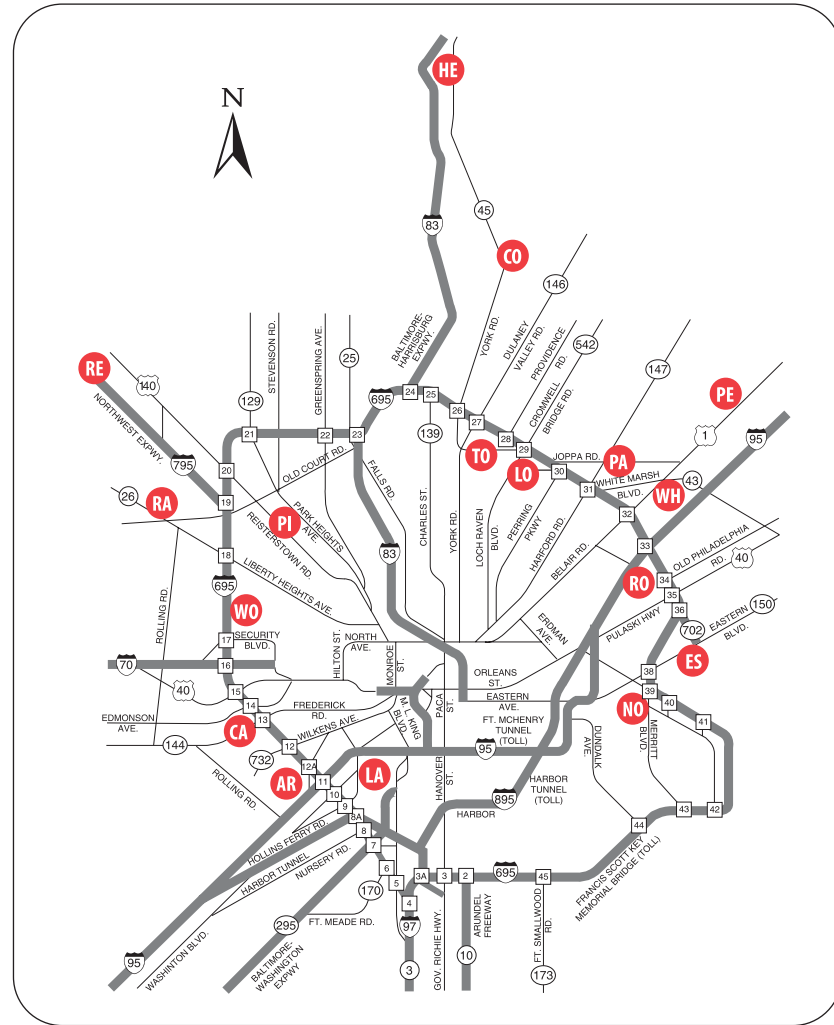

By: Andrea Zimmerman

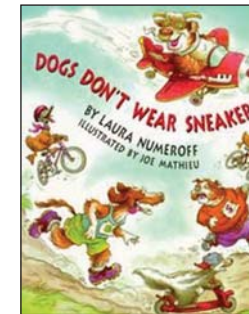
Follow Mr. Rally and his dog, Lightning, as they travel the town on a big yellow digging machine, taking care of five important jobs.

By: Laura Numeroff

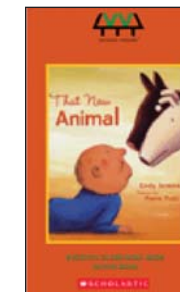
In a child's imagination, animals do wacky things, including ducks riding bikes, yaks skiing and fish eating bagels.

By: Emily Jenkins

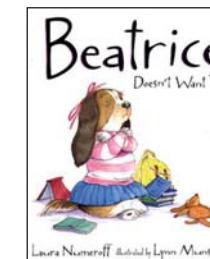
The lives of two dogs change after an intruding new animal (a baby) comes into their home.

By: Laura Numeroff

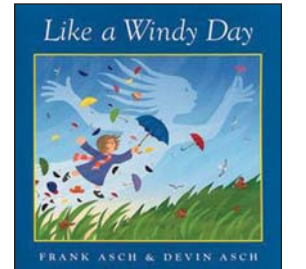
On the third afternoon of going to the library with her brother Henry, Beatrice finally finds something she enjoys doing.

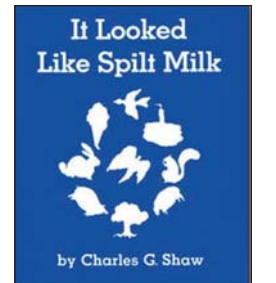
A young girl discovers all the things the wind can do by playing and dancing along with it.

By: Charles G. Shaw

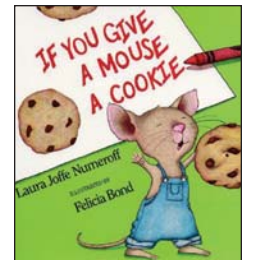
Clouds take on the shape of different objects as they drift by in the sky.

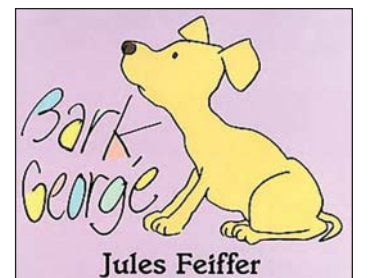
Relating the cycle of requests a mouse is likely to make after you give him a cookie takes the reader through a young boy's day.
