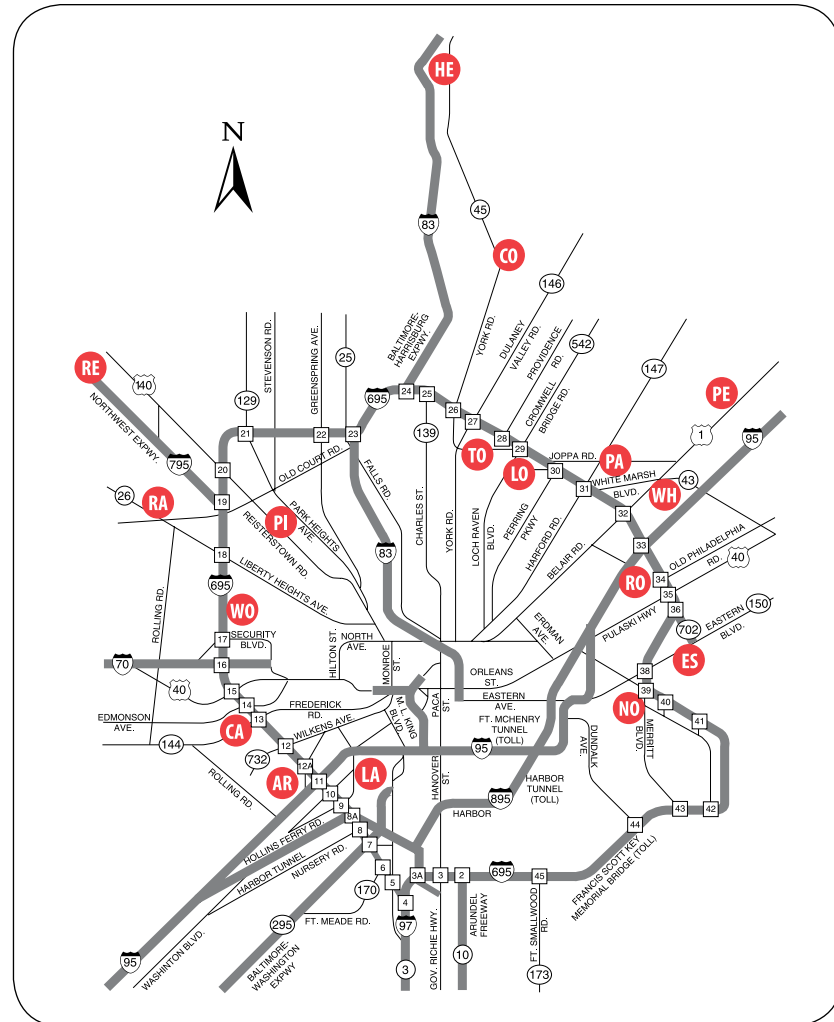

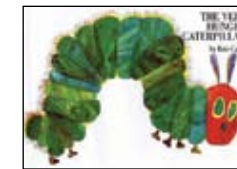
When Mom or Dad asks what you did today, you can tell them ReadRover came to read and play!

By: Eric Carle

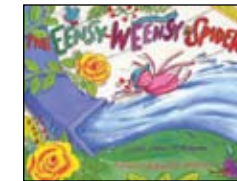

By: Jim Aylesworth

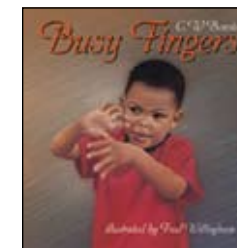
Rhyming text and illustrations follow a mischievous old black fly through the alphabet as he has a very busy bad day landing where he should not be.

By: Bill Martin Jr.

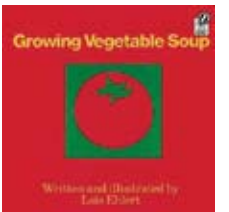
An alphabet chant that relates what happens when the whole alphabet tries to climb a coconut tree.

Reading with Your Child
