- Attend the initial training on Thursday, January 25 from 6:00 – 8:00 PM (snow date 2/1);
- Meet with your buddy **every week** from February 5 – March 29;
- Notify your buddy’s parent and the library if you will not be able to attend a session;
- Sign in before each session and maintain a record of your activities;
- Maintain regular communication with the Reading Buddies coordinators, including signing up for our Remind notification group;
- Dress suitably for work in the library; be neat and well-groomed.
